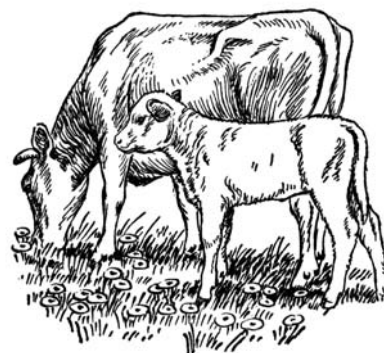


What's New With NRCS?
